CONTINUE TO PRAY FOR THE ROMA PEOPLE

- PRAY That the Roma people will know that God is for them and not against them. That they would rightly see themselves as purposefully created by God in the image of God
- PRAY That the Roma people would be set free from cultural and generational bondage in the areas of broken relationships (i.e. marriage and family); addiction; poverty; pagan practices and restored to healthy relationships with God through Christ and others
- PRAY that the Roma would be set free from spiritual and cultural oppression: dependance on government; usuary; rejection by surrounding culture; illiteracy. Provide for them meaningful work and education in their mother tongue so that they can live and thrive and have enough to share with others in need. That they would find their meaning, hope and provision in Christ who sustains and prospers them.
- PRAY that Roma church members would take an active part in their churches, serving, being discipled and discipling, giving and reaching out to neighbors in need, trusting in God for his abundant provision....
- PRAY... "Lord, you are in the midst of us and we are called by your Name: Do not forsake us, O Lord our God.." Jeremiah 14:9,22

The first serves Eastern Europe (Serbia, North Macedonia, Croatia, and Slovenia), and the second covers Western Europe (Germany and Sweden).
- PRAY as Misha continues to travel throughout Europe speaking, teaching and exhorting pastors and leaders in the area of discipleship. Misha recently taught at a gathering in Germany, of primarily pastors, elders, and spiritual leaders from Roma churches across Germany. Praising God that there were approximately 40 highly engaged attendees.
- PRAY that through the practice of making disciples, Misha and affiliated teams, including RBU, can reach as many people as possible.
- PRAY that pastors understand that the true focus is not on the number of people attending the Sunday service, but on spiritual growth and making disciples.
- PRAY that Misha has the opportunity to meet new pastors and share this important teaching in their churches.
- PRAY that each of those who attended the gathering will focus upon Christ and the true mission of building His Church through discipleship and prioritize their own spiritual walk with Christ as they focus on their hearts, health, and families—being led by the mission of God, not the pressure of ministry.
- PRAY for Misha, his wife, and two children as they prepare for the arrival of their third child. May God guide, protect, and bless Misha and his family as he serves his Church in Leskovac and supports many Roma pastors and leaders in Serbia and across Southern Europe.
- Pray for traction regarding the Bible for Children. The vision is to transform printed and audio versions into an animated video to reach Roma children throughout Europe.

- PRAY for her church their community is small, and mostly elderly (they have already buried five members.)
- PRAY for Biljana's physical healing. She has been battling a
 misdiagnosed liver/kidney infection which resulted in worsened conditions
 due to mistreatment. She is on a new treatment, but not much improved.
 She is still struggling with stomach issues and hives, which are worsening
 with the warmer weather. Please pray for a breakthrough in her health
 and for total healing.

Nancy Hitching, RBU US Director

Thank you for praying for Nancy's process of setting up life (for the short term at least) here in the US in Maryland in the home of her eldest son.

 PRAY for Nancy as she continues the work of establishing (emails, calls, online accounts, documentation, etc) documentation/verification necessary to register with the government as regards Social Security documentation and health insurance. She has been able to obtain à US Bank account and à US phone plan, and other non-RBU personal life goals/tasks which have been delayed for the past nine months while focusing primarily on managing RBU tasks each day. Pray that she continues to be successful in accomplishing this long list of tasks/appointments, etc. with government agencies related to establishing residency in the US.

- PRAY that she finds a church community with which she can ecclesially identify.
- PRAY that she can develop a community of local friends with whom she can socialize. This was something lacking during her time spent in Croatia.
- PRAY that she is able to restart her scholarly research project and complete her PhD. She only has 2 more years until completion. Pray that the school which has agreed to take her thesis will allow her to continue at the tuition rate she had before Bob passed away (She was considered a British student since she was married to a British man.) She is 10 years into this research and wants to complete and defend the thesis.
- PRAY for Nancy as she takes a 6-7 week rest period (May-June) from her duties as the RBU US Director. She recently wrote to the RBU Board of Directors explaining that she required this time of rest after the intensive 9 months of committed focus on RBU work and projects. It is also a much needed time to focus on personal tasks, described above, which were set aside during this time. She plans to return to the US Director role after this rest period. PRAISE that she has already been successful in some of the necessary tasks. Please pray that she can both rest and be successful in lining up these necessary governmental and health care issues as well as get some 'down time' for rest, spiritual refreshment, and social interaction.
- PRAY that she will be able to return to her duties and continue the process of fundraising for the RBU General Fund in order to see an increase in monthly giving designated to the continued running of the mission.
- PRAY that Nancy will continue to seek God for future direction in her life, that she can hear His voice clearly as to how to balance the level of RBU work and figuring out how to live alone for the first time in nearly 30 years.
